Mayors Notes

Effective June 1, 2010 all rental property will be inspected before the water will be turned on at the residence. The inspection consists of a check list for the interior and exterior of the residence. The residence has to pass this inspection before the water will be turned on by the City Water Department. The inspection will consist of checking windows, walls, roof, yard, floors, breaker box and outlets, ceilings, smoke detectors, plumbing, and exits. Those that do not pass the inspection will have to be repaired, etc. before the water can be turned on.

USDA GRANT FOR P.E.R.T.

The City of Parma was approved for a grant through USDA for the emergency shelter at the old school cafeteria. The grant is in the amount of \$67,274 with the City having to match funds of \$16,874. The City will be receiving assistance on the matching funds from other agencies. The grant is to help purchase a generator, furnace, air conditioner, folding tables, freezer, etc.

USDA COMMUNITY CENTER GRANT

The City has also received a second grant from Rural Development in the amount of \$9700.00 to install a new heat pump furnace and air conditioning unit for the Community Center building Auditorium. This will replace a 20 year old unit that is not fully operational.

FIRE CHIEF NOTES

At the annual Down Home Days Picnic this year we will once again have a gas grill for raffle to raise money for equipment, training, etc. Also if things go according to plan we will raffle a painted Parma Pirate for your wall. Once again tickets can be bought from any fire department member starting in June or at the picnic. Prices are \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00.



The Fire Department is hoping to start a first responder program in July and we are hoping a few citizens might be interested in joining. Applicants must be responsible, able to work with others well, felony free, willing to show up when needed at ALL hours of day and night and also should be able to lift patients without injury. If so, contact us at 357-2006 or come to our meetings on the first Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m. at the fire shed for further information.

As of May 21, 2010 the Parma Fire Department has had nineteen (19) calls. These include structure, vehicle fires, smoke calls, air evac stand-bys, and false alarms. We had seven (7) fires, two (2) false alarms, eight (8) air evac stand-bys, and two (2) medical assists with the ambulance.

We ask that all residents assist us with updating/advising of citizens on oxygen, dialysis, etc. This list of citizens is needed so that when our City is with out power, etc. for an extended time, we can check on each one to make sure that they are doing fine and get them oxygen if needed. Please notify us or the City Hall of any changes or updates. Thank You!
